Operational definition of clinical for schools of nursing in Nevada

Clinical experiences in nursing education approved by the Nevada State Board of Nursing consist of a variety of experiences with actual patients across the lifespan throughout the curriculum. Innovative teaching/learning methods such as simulation may be utilized. Nevada Nursing programs must consistently provide actual patient experiences sufficient to prepare the nursing student for competency as defined in NAC 632.212, 632.214, 632.216, 632.218, 632.220 and 632.222
