The role of the RN in Intrauterine Insemination (IUI)

It is within the scope of the RN to perform IUI procedures, which is an addition to the previous decision by the board made on July 24, 1992. This is considering it is within the facility policy and the following criteria have been met.

1. There is an order from the attending licensed healthcare provider.
2. The RN has demonstrated competencies set forth by the facility.
3. The RN has the advanced training in IUI required to perform the procedure.
